

Thank you for showing interest in the Student Representative to the University of Missouri Board of Curators position. This position rotates every two years to a campus within the University of Missouri System and plays a crucial role in voicing students' interests at the highest level of system governance. During the 2014-2016 term, the position will be held by a student from the University of Missouri – St. Louis. The Student Representative is uniquely positioned to participate in events, networking, and decision making that affects all 75,011 students across the four campuses.

All applicants must be able to meet the criteria listed in the attached Job Descriptions/Expectations and should be aware that a criminal background check is a part of the selections process. Ideal candidates for this position are students possessing strong communication skills and the ability to apply these skills in representing student interests to individuals, small and large groups, and public audiences in a variety of environments. Professionalism, enthusiasm, dependability, flexibility, the ability and willingness to fulfill the considerable time commitment and travel requirements outlined in the Job Description/Expectations are all essential to successfully functioning in this position.

Student Representative to the Board of Curators Job Description/Expectations

The Student Representative to the University Of Missouri Board Of Curators is a prestigious position whereby one student is chosen every two years to present the interests of 75,000+ students that attend one of the four universities in the UM-System. A student from the University of Missouri-St. Louis (UMSL) will have the honor of being the next Student Representative.

The Board of Curators acts as the governing board of the UM-System, making decisions regarding finances, degree offerings, and other topics vital to the inner workings of all four universities. The Student Representative serves as a non-voting member of this nine-person board and will be allowed in all public and private sessions. Past Student Representatives have gone on to become congressmen and women, law partners, and CEOs. This position is not only essential to student representation within the board, but also an invaluable experience in which a student has the ability to assist in the governing of Missouri's second largest employer and an institution responsible for a 2 billion dollar economic impact.

The Student Representative to the Board of Curators must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of the state of Missouri, and maintain full-time student status on the campus of University of Missouri-St. Louis until the position expires – a period of two years (January 2014- January 2016) per Missouri Statute 172.035. Full time status for undergraduates is 12 credit hours per semester and for graduates is 6 credit hours per semester. For the term of the position, the Student Representative must also remain in good academic standing. The weekly time commitment for this role will vary between ten and forty hours, but the Student Representative to the Board of Curators can expect to put in an average of 20 hours per week. Given the time commitment of this position, the Student Representative with their faculty to ensure they are academically successful.

The Student Representative will attend all Board of Curators' meetings and events. This individual will also attend meetings with the UM-System administration, Inter-campus Student Council, and all other appropriate groups and organizations. The Student Representative may also be required to speak to various student groups during his or her term.

The position will also require extensive travel throughout Missouri; therefore, the Student Representative will be required to provide his or her own means of transportation. Most of the travel will be between the four UM-System Universities, but travel to other locations will also be required. A stipend will be provided for travel and lodging expenses from the student governments of the UM-System universities.

This is not a paid position.

Professional dress will be expected at most meetings.

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TIMELINE FOR THE SELECTION PROCESS

Week of August 1st, 2013- Announcement of this position to the student body and release of the application

August 12, 2013- Posters placed around campus and distributed to departments

August 23, 2013- Email to all UMSL students, faculty, and staff

September 6, 2013- Final email to UMSL campus community

September 9, 2013- Open Forum with Student Body President (4:00 PM, Location: SGA Chambers)

September 13, 2013- Deadline for Applications and Supporting Documents to the Office of Student Life (Attn: Bennett Felton, Student Government President) in 366 Millennium Student Center

Week of September 23-27, 2013- UMSL Campus Interviews, (1st Round, All Candidates) 15minute interviews of applicants. Letters will be sent to applicants notifying them of their status

Week of October 7-11, 2013-ISC/ASUM Selection Committee Interviews, (2nd Round, Top 6 Candidates) 45- minute interviews of applicants. Selection committee will deliberate at the completion of the interviews to discuss and choose three applicants to submit to the Governor of Missouri

November 21-22, 2013-Board of Curators Meeting at UMSL (3rd Round, Top 3 Candidates)

Week of December 2-6, 2013-Submission of names to Missouri Governor's office. Letters will be sent to applicants notifying them of their status

The Governor's office will do another round of interviews prior to selection the final candidate. More information regarding this portion of the process will be provided later.

Before filling out this application, an interested applicant must read the Job Description/Expectations provided with this form. In order to submit this application, everything must be typed. Completed Applications should be submitted to the Office of Student Life (Attn: Bennett Felton, Student Government President) in 366 Millennium Student Center. Applicants must submit their applications prior to the close of business (5:00 PM) on Friday, September 13, 2013 in order to continue through the process. Applications must be fully completed when submitted.

Please include an unofficial college transcript. Graduate students should provide baccalaureate and if applicable, masters/professional degree transcripts. Upon notification, the three finalists will be required to provide an official university transcript to be sent to the governor.

SECTION 4: PERSONAL STATEMENT

Please include essay answers to the following questions:

What do you see as the most important issue (s) that face (s) the University of Missouri system currently and how can the issue (s) be addressed by the Student Representative to the Board of Curators?

What skills and experience would you bring to the Student Representative to the Board of Curators position and how would you use them to address what you consider to be the important student issues?

Answers to each question should be limited to 1-3 pages, double-space, 12 point Times New Roman font. Please include your full name on each of the pages.

SECTION 5: LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Please include three letters of recommendation. There is one form included in this packet, for each form, fill in your name and complete the waiver (Print three Student Representative to the Board of Curators Letter of Recommendation Nomination Form). Finally, give the forms to the three people who will be writing letters for you. You may wish to furnish the people writing your recommendation with a copy of the Student Representative to the Board of Curators Job Description/Expectations.

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OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Each finalist of this process will undergo an extensive check of his/her criminal record and credit history. The Missouri State Highway Patrol, Missouri State Senate and the Missouri Governor's Office will each conduct a background check of the finalists.
